RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ROEBLING ROAD RACEWAY

Please take a moment to read and become informed. Roebing Road Raceway wants all of us to enjoy our visit and asks that we please observe these rules. Observing these guidelines and respecting the rights of those in their community will ensure that everyone has a great time, and will help them to maintain Roebing Road's great atmosphere. Thank you.

1. SPEED LIMIT when entering the track on neighboring roads is 35mph. Speed limit inside the paddock is 5mph.
2. ALL persons entering Roebing Road Raceway are required to sign the track waiver forms.
THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. NO fireworks, firearms, weapons or illegal drugs.
4. NO ATVs, ATCs, Pit Bikes, Dirt Bikes or Motorized Scooters allowed at any time.
5. Please place ALL TRASH in the trash barrels.
IMPORTANT: There are THREE WASTE FLUID STATIONS:
Dump WASTE OIL into 55 gallon drums marked 'WASTE OIL.'
Dump WASTE FUEL into 55 gallon drums marked 'WASTE FUEL.'
Dump COOLANT into 55 gallon drums marked "COOLANT"
Dump BRAKE FLUID into 35 gallon drum located at the FUEL STATION marked "BRAKE FLUID."
Any cross-contamination of the above-mentioned fluids will result in a \$1,000 fine to the The Dark Side.
6. NO loud music or bass-boomers. All noise should cease at 10PM. Be considerate of neighbors.
7. PETS ALLOWED. They need their required shots and must be on a leash at all times
8. NO ANIMALS are allowed in the buildings at Roebing Road Raceway.
9. CAMPFIRES/GROUND FIRES are NOT allowed at Roebing Road Raceway
10. DO NOT tape notices to any painted surfaces. It removes the paint. Bulletin boards are provided in rest rooms and by result boards.
11. ABSOLUTELY NO imbedding new brakes and/or testing vehicles on infield roadways
12. NO CROSSING allowed while vehicles are on the track.
13. NO RACE ENGINES TO BE RUN BEFORE 8AM OR AFTER 8PM. \$100 FINE FOR VIOLATORS. If personal cars are being used for the weekend, these engines should be turned off as soon as they are parked until 0800.
14. NO JUMPING on any fences. VIOLATORS WILL BE EVICTED!
15. DO NOT stand on PIT WALL or APPLY any tape to PIT WALL.
16. CHILDREN under 18 are not allowed in the HOT PITS or GRID AREA.
17. TRACK is closed to ALL MOTORIZED vehicles at the end of the day's event. You may walk or bicycle at this time.
18. DO NOT damage any grassy area in ANY MANNER
19. DRIVING counter-race is strictly forbidden at all times.
20. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are allowed after the last race of the day. Any use during the races, will result in eviction from the track.
21. REPORT OIL and FUEL SPILLS to officials, so it may get cleaned up. REMEMBER we are under the watchful eye of the EPA.
22. EACH participant shall have at least (1) portable Dry Chemical Fire Extinguisher with a rating of at least 12BC available and in good working condition in their pit area.
23. DECIBEL LIMITS are set at 103 db. The track will provide a trained sound control technician at your event. If the driver has exceeded the 103db limit; the driver will be black flagged, brought in, told of the infraction and given a chance to correct the situation. If the driver is not able to correct the noise level, the driver will be asked to pull the entered vehicle from the event.
24. SUNDAY QUIET TIME — In observance of local church services, the track will observe quiet time on Sundays from 11am till 12 noon. Absolutely NO ENGINES during this time.
25. During an event, it is the Lessee's responsibility to assure the safety and security of the track property for all participants. Lessee assumes responsibility and is subject to being invoiced for damage to the track and its facilities, arising from abuse or misuse of same. Failure to comply with this provision may result in Lessee being required to post a damage bond at future events.
26. Lessee is responsible for and will be billed separately for materials and equipment damaged or expended during their event, including but not limited to fire bottles, brooms, speedy dri, guard rails and repairs to track surface.
27. IT IS REQUIRED THAT THE LESSEE INFORM ALL PARTICIPANTS OF THE CHARGES AND REGULATIONS SET FORTH IN THIS CONTRACT.
28. TRACK MANAGEMENT reserves the right to bar, expel or fine any individual(s) in violation of any rule or regulation.
